#### SHARING OF THE ASSIGNED SCRIPTURE READINGS

#### Romans 16:25-27

Paul closes his letter to the Romans by praising God because, in the proclamation of the gospel of Jesus Christ, God has revealed the promised, divine plan of salvation for all humanity. Paul proclaims this gospel of Christ in order to bring about the obedience of faith among all nations.

<sup>25</sup>Now to God who is able to strengthen you according to my gospel and the proclamation of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery that was kept secret for long ages <sup>26</sup>but is now disclosed, and through the prophetic writings is made known to all the Gentiles, according to the command of the eternal God, to bring about the

obedience of faith—<sup>27</sup>to the only wise God, through Jesus Christ, to whom be the glory forever! Amen.

#### Luke 1:26-38

In this annunciation, Luke makes clear that God comes with good news for ordinary people from little known places. This king will not be born to royalty in a palace, but to common folk in a stall. Here Luke highlights the role of the Spirit, a special emphasis in this gospel.

<sup>26</sup>In the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent by God to a town in Galilee called Nazareth, <sup>27</sup>to a virgin engaged to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David. The virgin's name was Mary. <sup>28</sup>And he came to her and said, "Greetings, favored one! The Lord is with you." <sup>29</sup>But she was much perplexed by his words and pondered what sort of greeting this might be. 30The angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. <sup>31</sup>And now, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you will name him Jesus. 32He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Most High, and the Lord God will give to him the throne of his ancestor David. 33He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of his kingdom there will be no end." 34Mary said to the angel, "How can this be, since I am a virgin?" 35The angel said to her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you; therefore the child to be born will be holv: he will be called Son of God. 36And now, your relative Elizabeth in her old age has also conceived a son; and this is the sixth month for her who was said to be barren. <sup>37</sup>For nothing will be impossible with God." 38Then Mary said, "Here am I, the servant of the Lord; let it be with me according to your word." Then the angel departed from her.

Christmas Eve Worship at Holy Trinity. In response to NJ COVID state regulations regarding attendance capacity and physical distancing, the Holy Trinity Council voted unanimously to offer two worship services on Christmas Eve: 3:30pm and 5:00pm. State legislation mandates a maximum attendance of 60 people for each of these liturgies. An RSVP "sign-up sheet" was electronically emailed to you prior to Thanksgiving, and a hard-copy sign-up sheet is located in the rear of the sanctuary. Please sign up at either of these venues. Those who intend to worship "in person" will be granted first-come, first serve privileges for the sign up. Of course, the services will be offered live via the internet and archived for viewers to enjoy at any time. We regret any inconvenience this arrangement may pose for you or your family members, but we must be in compliance with CDC and state mandates during the pandemic.

#### Some things you should know....

- In many ways, our sanctuary set-up and physical-distancing protocols exceed CDC guidelines for safe public gatherings
- The air blowers which heat the sanctuary are turned off at least thirty minutes prior to worship and are never re-activated so as to avoid spraying breath aerosol into the environment when people are in the sanctuary
- We are currently reaching approximately 200 people on Sundays and throughout the week with our YouTube streamed worship

services. Viewers are connecting with us from several states, including, Texas, Florida, Tennessee, and the Carolinas

- Weekly Sunday School lessons are posted on our church's web page in addition to the weekly children's sermons
- Thermal-insulated curtains have been installed in one of our meeting rooms to save on energy costs
- Souvenir battery-powered candles will be given to all Christmas Eve attendees in order to avoid spraying breath aerosol when attempting to "blow out" traditional candles.
- All liturgical wording for our worship bulletins is obtained from the national office of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (ELCA)
- Pastor Jack has been appointed by the Bishop to serve as the Synod's Western Mission District Dean and Cluster Counselor. He will assist the Bishop in providing support to clergy and congregations in Morris, Sussex, and Warren County
- During the pandemic, community groups (other than Holy Trinity groups) have not been meeting inside our building
